

DuPage Golf Play Safe Precautions Restore Illinois – Phase 4



In order to comply with [“Phase 4 Restrictions” mandated by the Governor's office](#), and to help ensure the wellbeing of golfers and our staff, the following procedures are in place at The Preserve, Maple Meadows, and Green Meadows. Please read this entire document and share it with your playing partners. Thanks!

Plan Ahead

- **Reservations are required** for all golfers. Walk-up play without a tee time is discouraged, and online reservations are preferred.
- **A credit card is required** to make a reservation, and discounts may be available for prepayment at the time of booking.
- **Carts – limited availability.** Two riders per cart are permitted during Phase 4 of the Governor's plan. Golfers are expected to ride together in order to ensure enough carts are available for all tee times. According to State guidelines, golfers should wear face coverings while in the cart together.
- Requests for individual carts will be considered only for off-peak times when practical. Additional fees may apply for individual carts.
- For any transaction at the golf course, **credit cards are preferred.**
- Golfers with any **symptoms of COVID-19**, should not play. **Spectators** are not allowed.

Upon Arrival

- Proceed to the pro shop for confirmation and check-in. To ensure sanitary conditions, please do not put your equipment on a golf cart until you receive a cart assignment and key.
- **Practice areas – limited availability.** Per the Governor's orders, golfers should remain a minimum of six feet apart in these areas.
- **Takeout Counter** – a selection of to-go food and beverages are available for purchase – **credit cards are preferred.**

On the Course

- **Touchpoints eliminated.** Bag drop, benches, ball washes, bunker/sand trap rakes, water coolers, and drinking fountains are restricted by the State. **Golfers are encouraged to bring their own source of water and hand sanitizer.**
- Please **don't touch** the **flagstick.** The bottom of the **cups are elevated** so balls can be retrieved after putting without touching the flagstick or hole.
- Practice **social distancing** throughout the round. No handshakes. Handle only your own scorecard and golf equipment. **No gathering in groups larger than 50.**

Additional Information

- Restrooms and any other common surfaces are sanitized frequently. **Players are encouraged** to bring their own hand sanitizer.
- Tee times must be cancelled at least 24 hours in advance. Any credits for cancellation may be in the form of a **rain check only.**
- Per local liquor law, golfers **may not bring** their own alcoholic beverages. A selection of beverages to-go are available from the takeout counter.
- Trash can lids are removed for touchless access. Please help keep the course litter free and empty your own trash from the golf cart.
