

DuPage Golf Spectator Policy

Requests to access the golf course as a non-golfing spectator will be considered for “off-peak” times, including weekends and holidays **after** 2:00pm and most weekdays. Management reserves the right to refuse spectator access at any time, and will not permit spectators at times when the course is busy. **To avoid disappointment, we strongly suggest calling ahead to discuss your request.**

The following rules and fees apply to spectator access:

- The course access fee for a non-golfing spectator is \$5 (walk-along).
- If riding along, the applicable cart ride fee will also apply based on day and time.
- No more than one spectator per foursome
- No more than two people may ride in a golf cart at any time.
- Spectators are not permitted to partake in any play on the course, and must remain with their group at all times.
- Groups with spectators must “keep pace” by staying within 10 minutes or a half hole of the group in front of them. Spectators will be removed from the course if the group they are spectating cannot “keep pace.”
