## Junior Preservers Golf Clinics

The goal of this program is to establish strong fundamentals of the game of golf. Instruction will focus on golf etiquette, short and long game skills, and on-course play. This class will combine instruction and games with on-course learning activities. Students may register for either of the 3-day clinics.

Target Student: Junior that has completed a beginner instructional program.

Recommended Student Age: 7 to 14 years old      Student to Instructor Ratio: 10 to 1

Dates & Times: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday June 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, or July 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, August 1<sup>st</sup>. 6:00pm to 7:30pm

## Birdie Golf League

While attention will be given to overall swing fundamentals, the majority of this program will focus on on-course playing opportunities.

Target Student: Experienced junior looking for on-course play opportunities capable of playing with limited supervision.

Recommended Student Age: 8 to 14 years old      Student to Instructor Ratio: 12 to 1

## Eagle Golf League

This program will focus on refinement of full swing and short game skills preparing students for competitive play. Each class will begin with an hour long instructional period, followed by on-course playing opportunities.

Target Student: The final level of our development series is geared towards experienced juniors seeking to refine existing skills.

Recommended Student Age: 12 to 18 years old      Student to Instructor Ratio: 6 to 1
