## Teaching Philosophy

I’ve been a PGA member for 30 years and have been mentored by numerous PGA Professionals. Many of these professionals have tour experience or have worked with tour players. I have taught tour players to beginners . It doesn’t matter on the ability level everybody can improve !

My style is eclectic in nature , being that there is no one way to swing or strike a golf ball.

I like to teach the “why” not the “how”

With this in mind there are basic fundamentals such as grip, posture , alignment , stance , ball position that make it easier to find the low point of the swing.

By focusing on this area first , your learning curve will move quickly and you will see positive results.

I like to see what natural ability and nice movements a player has before making any adjustments.

My theory is polish the diamond , don’t break it into a million pieces at the start.

As the student starts to hit the center of the face , we move into swing path and positions. This will allow the player /coach to work together and find a happy place.

My goal is to find a consistent ball flight that can be trusted on the course. The end result being lower scores and more fun !
